










PLACES TO SEE - RIVERFRONT TRAIL

From the base of the Ambassador Bridge, this paved, two-lane trail extends east for 5 km along the riverfront parkland to Hiram Walker distillery in historic Walkerville.


PLACES TO SEE - Ambassador Bridge

The Windsor-Detroit border is the busiest international crossing in North America. More than 40,000 commuters cross each day.



PLACES TO SEE - Festival Plaza

Located along the banks of the Detroit River, between the river and Casino Windsor. It has over 100,000 square feet of festival space.



PLACES TO SEE - PEACE FOUNTAIN & COVENTRY GARDENS

In honour of Charles Brooks and his efforts towards world peace, the Charles Brooks "Peace Fountain" in Coventry Gardens in Windsor exists as a standing monument to his endeavours and achievements.

A showplace and tourist attraction on the banks of the Detroit River, Coventry Garden was designed for relaxation and recreation. It features the Peace Fountain, the only international floating fountain in the world, which can propel water 70 feet in the air and displays a light show at night.








THINGS TO DO - TRY YOUR LUCK AT CAESARS WINDSOR

Willistead Manor was the home of Edward Chandler Walker, son of Hiram Walker the Windsor whisky legend and creator of famous Canadian Club Whisky. Coming from an extremely wealthy background and living in a town named after his family 'Walkerville' (now Windsor), Edward Chandler Walker commissioned famous architect Albert Kahn to build a luxurious and grand home for his wife and himself.



DIRECTIONS TO DIMACHEM - FROM THE BRIDGE


FROM THE BRIDGE:

Take ON-3 and EC. Row Expy E to Howard Ave. Take the Howard Avenue exit from E C. Row Expy E

- Head southeast on ON-3
- Use the right lane to take the East.C.Row Expressway E ramp
- Merge onto E C. Row Expy E
- Take the Howard Avenue exit
- Keep right at the fork, follow signs for Howard Ave South and merge onto Howard Ave

Follow Howard Ave, Division Rd and Sydney Ave to Marentette Ave

- Merge onto Howard Ave
- Use the left lane to continue on Division Rd
- Turn left onto Sydney Ave
- Turn left onto Marentette Ave
- Dimachem Inc. will be on the right



DIRECTIONS TO DIMACHEM - FROM THE TUNNEL


FROM THE TUNNEL:

Follow Detroit Windsor Tunnel to McDougall St in Windsor, Canada

- Turn left onto Wyandotte St E
- Turn right onto McDougall St

Continue on Howard Ave to Sydney Ave

- Turn right onto Howard Ave
- Keep left to stay on Howard Ave
- Use the left lane to continue on Division Rd
- Turn left onto Sydney Ave
- Turn left onto Marentette Ave
- Dimachem Inc. will be on the right



DIRECTIONS TO DIMACHEM - FROM THE 401

FROM THE 401:

- Head northwest on ON-401 W
- Take exit 14 for Essex County Rd 46/Provincial Rd toward Airport/Walker Rd
- Keep right at the fork, follow signs for Essex
 County Road 46/Provincial Road/Walker Rd
 and merge onto Provincial Rd/Essex County
 Rd 46
- Continue to follow Provincial Rd
- Merge onto Division Rd
- Turn right onto Marentette Ave
- Dimachem Inc. will be on the right
